

Abstracts Granville Co NC Deeds 1746-1765

211,213- Apr. 19, 1763- LODWICK ALFORD, merchant, to RICHARD UPCHURCH, planter, for 15 pds., 200 acres on N side of Crooked Creek on Augustine Hunnycutt's line. Witnesses: James Alford, Giles Driver.

213,214- Nov. 12, 1762- WILLIAM WILLIAMS to WILLIAM RARDON of Fairfax Co., VA. for 60 pds., 258 acres in Granville Co., NC, near Great Nut Bush Creek on Andersons Swamp, Reuben Searcy's line. Witnesses: Reuben Searcy.

214,215- Jan. 23, 1763- THOMAS BRIDGES to JOHN SCOT (SCOTCH) a deed of gift of 173 acres on S side of Cedar Creek, which is part of grant; to Bridges for 573 acres Nov. 27, 1760 at the creek where Joseph, the elder, has a mill. Witnesses: James Alford, Joseph Bridges.

215,216- Apr. 16, 1763- BENJAMIN THOMPSON and wife ELIZABETH to **THOMAS ROBERSON** for 50 pds., 200 acres at William Simmons' line along Joshua Perry's line, John Gibbs' line. Witnesses: Michael Whatley, John Gibbs.

218,219- Feb. 19, 1763 - DANIEL HUNTER to **WILLIAM BRIANT** of Brunswick Co., Va. for 70 pds., 215 acres on both sides of Ruin Creek and Tabbs Creek, on George Woodlief's corner, being part of 431 acres granted Daniel Hunter by John Smith May 8, 1760. Witnesses: John Smith, John Herndon.

219,220- Feb. 19, 1763- DANIEL HUNTER to JOHN HERNDON of Brunswick Co., VA., 110 pds., 216 acres on Tabbs Creek and Ruin Creek at Daniel Hunter's and **BRIANT's** lines, granted Hunter by John Smith May 8, 1760. Witnesses: **WILLIAM BRIANT**.
