Know all men by these presents, that I, **WILLIAM LEE** of Johnston County for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current money to me in hand paid by **JAMES SHAW** of the same county the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge myself, fully satisfied, have bargained, sold and do by these presents do bargain, sell and deliver unto the said **JAMES SHAW**, one negro named DAVID to have and to hold, the said negro unto his only proper use and behoof of him, the said **JAMES SHAW**, his heirs, executors, administrators for ever, and I the said **WILLIAM LEE**, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators do and shall warrant and defend the right and title of the said negro unto the said **JAMES SHAW**, his heirs, executors, administrators for ever.

In witness whereof I have hereunto have set my hand and seal this 25<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1789.
