Know all men by these presents that I **WILLIAM CRIDDLE** of the state of North Carolina, Johnston County, for and in consideration of the sum of forty pounds specie to me in hand paid by the administrators of the estate of **NEEDHAM BRYAN**, deceased, of the county of Wake & state aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge myself full satisfied have bargained, sold & delivered, unto the said administrators all and every part of my movable property consisting of beds and furniture, pots, tables, loom, chairs, chests, pewter, pork, corn, & c. To them, their heirs and assigns forever. For myself, my heirs and assigns will warrant & forever defend the said bargained premises unto the said administrators of the estate of said deceased, their heirs & assigns forever against the lawful claim of any person or persons whatsoever.
