

**Deed, NC, Lincoln Euagustevus Brient 1801**

This indenture made the seventh day of February in the year of our Lord 1801 between **ROBERT WEER** of the county of Lincoln and state of North Carolina of the one part and **EUAGUSTEVUS BRIENT** of the state of South Carolina and York County of the other part.

Witnesseth that the said **ROBERT WEER** for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to him in hand paid the rest he doth acknowledge, and the said **ROBERT WEER** hath given, granted, bargained, & sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain & sell, alien and confirm unto the said **EUGUSTAVUS BRIENT** and all that tract or parcel of land situate, lying & being in the county aforesaid on the waters of the Little creek of Buffaloe joining said **ROBERT WEER's** and **JAMES G. BEATTY'S** land.

Beginning at a post oak, said **BEATTY's** corner, and runs thence with **WEER's** line North 180 poles to a pine then East 180 poles to a stake then South 180 poles to a pine, thence West to the beginning.

Containing 200 with the appurtenances situate, lying and being as aforesaid with their several of their rights, members & appurtenances to have, to hold unto the said **EUGUSTEVUS BRIENT**, his heirs and assigns forever and the said **ROBERT WEER** for himself and his executors & administrators doth promise, covenant & agree to and with the said **EUAGUSTEVUS BRIENT** that the the said **ROBERT WEER** shall and will at all times warrant & forever defend the above described tract of land unto the said **EUAGUSTEVUS BRIENT**, his heirs & assigns for ever against the claim or claims of him, the said **ROBERT WEER**, or any other person whatsoever.
