


Deed, NC, Tryon, John Carrol, 1772



North Carolina

JOHN CARROL [Carroll] 200 acres Tryon, on the S. side of the S. Fork of the Catawba River including his own improvements. Beginning at a Red Oak by some rocks & runs, N 180 poles to a Hickory; thence S 62 W 160 poles to a White Oak joining **PATTERSON**'s land; thence S 220 poles to a stake; thence N 70 E 150 poles to a stake; thence to the beginning.

Dated 22nd May 1772
