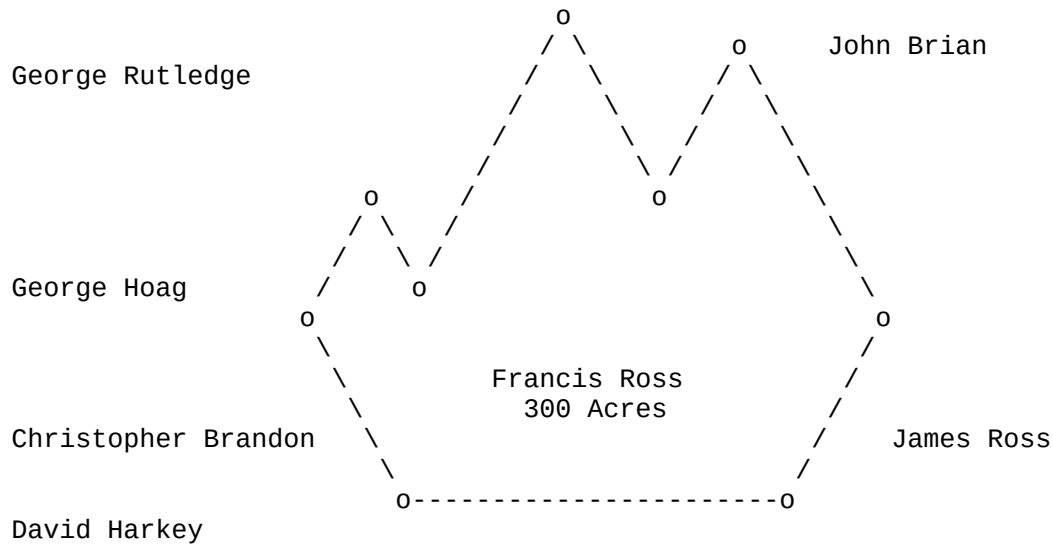


Deed, SC, Craven, Francis Ross, 1774



South Carolina

Pursuant to a precept from **JOHN BREMAR**, Esquire, Deputy Surveyor General, dated the 4th day of May 1773, I have admeasured & laid out unto **FRANCIS ROSS** a plantation or tract of land containing three hundred acres situate in Craven County and on a Branch of Turkey Creek, butting & bounding to the NW by **GEORGE RUTLEGE [RUTLEDGE]** & NE by **JOHN BRIAN**'s line & SE by **JAMES ROSS**' line & SW by **CHRISTOPHER BRANDON**'s line & W & S by **GEORGE HOAG**'s [Hogg] line & SW by **DAVID HARKEY**'s line being bound on all sides & hath such shape, form and marks as the above plat represents .
