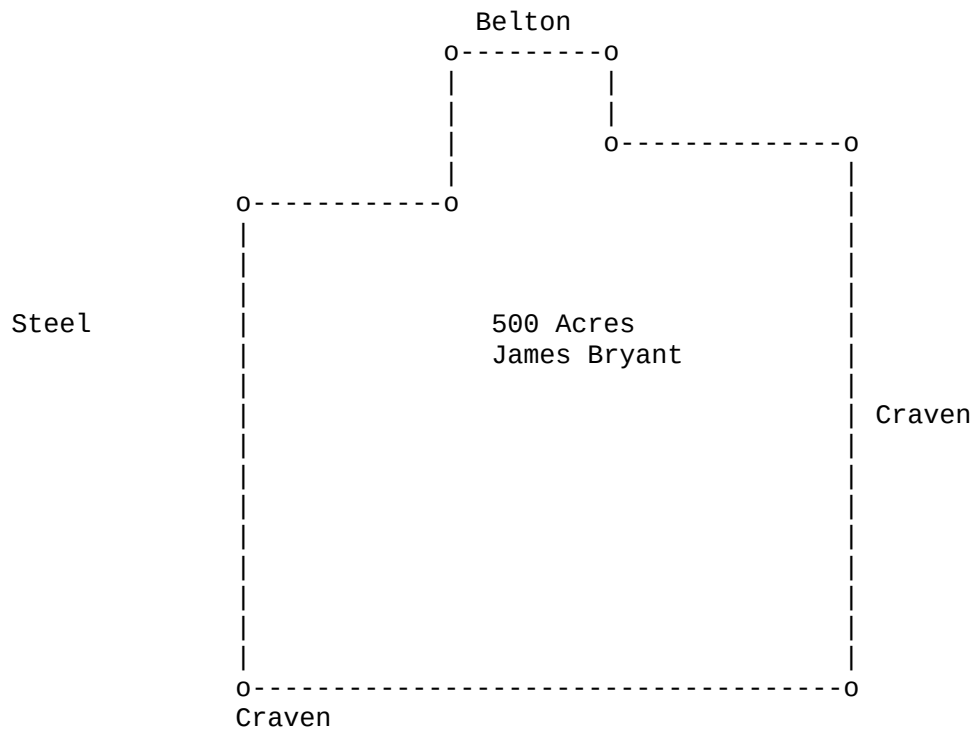


Deed, SC, Fairfield, James Bryant, 1800



South Carolina
Fairfield District

Pursuant to a warrant from **SAMUEL W. YONGUE** [Young], Commissioner of locations in the District aforesaid, I have admeasured and laid out a certain tract of land to **JAMES BRYANT** [Bryan] containing five hundred acres lying on the waters of Colonel's Creek, branch of the Wateree River binding NE and SW on **CRAVEN**'s land, SW and NW on **ISAAC HOUGHTON**'s land SW on **BELTON**'s [BOLTON] land, SE & SW on **JAMES BRYANT**'s land; SW on **STEEL**'s land and have such forms and marks as the the above plat represents.

Given under my hand this 21st day of April 1804
