Beginning at a Black Oak on the old line, about 10 or 15 rods from a Black Oak corner of the old track on the west side of the road which goes from VIOLET WATSON's to HUGH BERRY's old place; thence N 86 W 176 poles to a stake on WILLIAM MARTIN's line; thence S 79 W 123 poles to a Hickory; thence S 16 E 260 poles to a Black Jack by the Great Road; thence S 65 E 57 poles to a Black Jack; thence N 33 E 339 poles to the beginning.

CONTAINING by estimation 314 Acres, be the same more or less.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned on to the said **GEORGE DAVIES** his heirs and assigns forever so that neither we or our heirs, executors, administrators or either of us or them or any other person or persons shell or will any way or by any means whatsoever here after have claim, challenge, or demand any right, title, interest, they're in or they're too.
