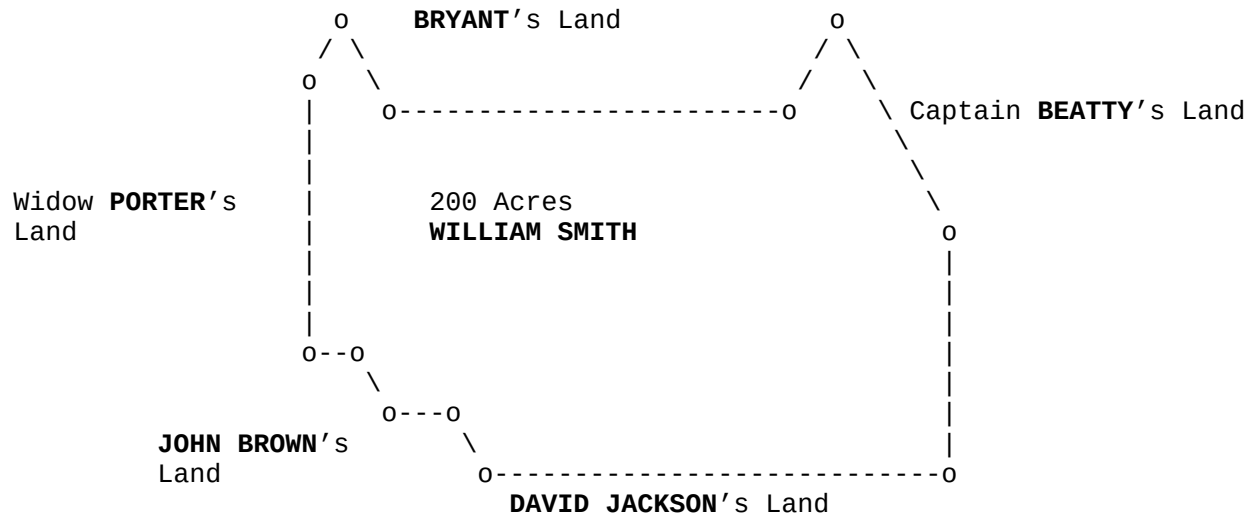


Deed, SC, York, William Smith 1818



South Carolina

I do hereby certify for the Honorable **WILLIAM SMITH** a plantation or tract of 200 acres of land surveyed for him 23rd of June 1818.

Situate in York District on a fork of Fishing Creek waters of the Catawba River, including an old improvement, known by the name of **JOHN WILSON's**, bounded by the line running SW by **DAVID JACKSON's** land; SE by Captain **BEATTY's** land; NE by **JAMES BRYANT's** land; NW by widow **PORTER's** land and SW by **JOHN BROWN's** land and have such form and marks as the above plat represents.

Given under my hand this 30th of June 1818
