To all, we do hereby give and grant unto **JOHN BRYAN** a tract of land containing six hundred and forty acres lying on Chowan precinct on the south side of Morattock River.

Beginning at a pine in the Cypress Swamp then N 46 E 140 pole to **JOHN BRYAN** Jr. corner, two Hickory & and a White Oak; then along his line N 20 W 240 pole to a Gum in a Slash **BRYAN** Jr. Corner tree and **JOHN HAMILTON**'s corner; then along **HAMILTON**'s line N 44 W 320 pole to a "papa" Gum, supposed to have been a Cypress, another of **HAMILTON**'s corner trees and **ARTHUR DAVIS**'s line tree; then along his line S 46 W 140 pole to a live Oak one of **DAVIS**'s line trees in the Cypress Swamp; thence the various courses of the Swamp to the first station.
