

**Land Grant, NC, Edgecombe, Thomas Bryant 1737**

George II & c.

Know ye that we have given and granted to **THOMAS BRYANT** four hundred acres of land lying in Edgecombe County on the south side of Tar River.

Beginning at a pine, his own corner tree; running thence East 40 poles to a ...; thence South 160 poles to a ... ; thence West 320 pulls to the center of Three Trees on **FRANCIS GRICE**'s line; thence along the said **GRICE**'s line 160 poles to a White Oak in **THOMAS BRYANT** line at the head of a bottom; thence East along the said **BRYANT**'s line 320 poles to the first station.
