

Land Grant, NC, Edgecombe, Thomas Bryant

THOMAS BRYANT 520 acres of land and Edgecombe County.

Beginning at his own corner White Oak in a branch on the south side of Fishing Creek then N 4 W 242 poles to **THOMAS FOXHALL**'s corner pine; then W 113 poles to **FOXHALL**'s other corner; then along **FOXHALL**'s headline N 33 E 220 poles to **HUDNELL**'s Corner line; then N 36 E 160 poles along **HUDNELL**'s line to Fishing Creek; then up Fishing Creek the various courses 58 poles to a white oak by the creek; then S 30 W 200 poles along **TAYLOR**'s line to a white oak and Pine; then W 114 poles to a Pine; then S 160 poles to a white oak; then W 68 poles to an Oak; then S 128 poles to a Black Oak; then S 11.15 E 234 poles to **HART**'s corner sweet gum; then along **HART**'s line to the first station.
