State of North Carolina

Know ye that we have granted onto **HENRY BULLINGER** one hundred acres in Lincoln County joining **DANIEL MCKISSICK, JAMES MARTIN** and **SNIDER's** line on the waters of [Maden] Maiden creek.

Beginning at a black oak on **MCKISSICK's** line; thence north sixty nine degrees east eighty poles to a post oak; thence north twenty one degrees west forty poles to a post oak; thence north fifty two degrees east ninety six poles to a post oak supposed to be on **PATRICK OBRIEN's** line; thence south thirty eight degrees east twenty poles to a post oak; thence north fifty two degrees east eighty poles to a post oak; thence north thirty eight degrees west twenty two poles to a post oak on **MARTIN's** line; thence with said line and part of **MCKISSICK's** line west two hundred and twenty four poles to a stake in said **MCKISSICK's** line thence to the beginning.

To hold to the said **HENRY BULLINGER** his heirs and assigns forever dated the 18th of May 1789.
