State of North Carolina

Know ye that we have given and granted unto **JAMES BRYSON** a tract of land containing seventy three acres lying and being in our County of Lincoln.

Beginning at a pine his own old corner thence with said Line north seventy three east two hundred and fifty five poles to his other corner joining **WILLIAM EARWOOD**'s line thence with that line West two hundred poles to a chestnut and black oak said **EARWOOD**'s other corner; thence South thirty eight West one hundred poles to a post oak joining or near **JAMES MARTIN**'s land; thence South thirty eight West one hundred poles to a Post Oak joining or near **JAMES MARTIN**'s land; thence South ten West one hundred and forty poles to a stake on **VALENTINE CLINE**'s old line; thence with said line south sixty eight east sixty poles to a stake on his own old line, thence with said line to the beginning.

To hold to the said **JAMES BRYSON**, his heirs and assigns forever.
