By the act passed by Congress on February 19, 1791 granting vacant lands in the state of South Carolina, **JAMES BRYANT, Sr.**, received land.

His grant reads as follows:

WE HAVE GRANTED, and by these presents DO GRANT unto **JAMES BRIANT** Sen. his heirs and assigns, a plantation or tract of land containing forty five acres, surveyed for him the 4th of July, 1820, situate in York District on a branch of Fishing Creek waters of Catawba river, bounded by a line running

NW by **JAMES THOMPSONS** land,
NE by **ROBERT NEELY's** land and **JOHN MCCARTER's**,
SW by said **JAMES BRIANT** Sen."
