

Marriage, NC, Johnston, James Stallings to Ulrica Bryan, 1818

KNOW all men by these presents, that we **JAMES STALLINGS** and **ISAAC STALLINGS** are held and firmly bound unto JOHN BRANCH Governor, or his successors in office, in the full sum of five hundred pounds, current money, to be paid to the said Governor, his successors or assigns, for the which payment, well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executours and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated this 2nd day of April and Anno Domini 1818.

THE CONDITION of the above obligation as such, that whereas the above bounded **JAMES STALLINGS** have made application for a license for marriage to be celebrated between him and **ULRICA BRYAN** of the county aforesaid. Now, in case it shall not appear hereafter that there is any lawful cause or impediment to obstruct the said marriage, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
