The said **JOHN RYAN**, his executors, administrators or assigns, will be entitled also to receive and shall be paid if demanded, the principal sum of £161.2.10 on the 7th of April 1787.

And the said **JOHN RYAN** his executors, administrators or assigns, may make any purchases at any public sale of confiscated property, except such as shall be ordered by the legislature for special purposes, and this indent shall be received in payment.

For the true performance of the several payments in manner above entioned, the public treasury is made liable, and the faith of the State play by the aforesaid ACT.

The said **JOHN RYAN** his executors, administrators, or assigns will be entitled also to receive and shall be paid if demand at the principal sum of £271.8.4 on the thirteen of September 1787.

And the said **JOHN RYAN** his executors, administrators, or assigns, may make any purchase at any public sale of confiscated property, except such as shall be ordered by the legislature for special purposes, and this indent shall be received in payment.
