

Will, NC, Craven, Joanna Vendrick, 1804

In the name of God, Amen.

I, **JOANNA VENDRICK**, of the county of Craven, and state of North Carolina, do make and ordain this my last will and testament, in manner and form following:

IMPRIMIS I give unto my son **BRYAN VENDRICK** one table and bed and furniture, also one chest, and a pot trammel, to him and his heirs forever.

ITEM I give to my beloved daughter **PENELLOPE VENDRICK** my cattle and hogs to her and her heirs forever. I give to my daughter **PENELLOPE VENDRICK** all the rest of my property real and personal, to her and her heirs forever, with my crop of corn.

AND I ordain this, my last will and testament, and revoking all former wills by me made.

AND Lastly I constitute, appoint my beloved daughter **PENELLOPE VENDRICK** executor to this my last will and testament.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 4th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four.
