I **ALEXANDER ROBINSON** Senior do settle my worldly affairs as follows leaving to **WILLIAM ROBINSON** by will five shillings; **ROBERT ROBINSON** five shillings; **JAMES ROBINSON** five shillings; **RACHEL GIVENS** five shillings; **ALEXANDER ROBINSON** five shillings; **ANN ROBINSON** five shillings.

To **JOSEPH ROBINSON** the part of the place that he lives on with all the stock of horses, cattle, sheep, hogs and Jack, a Negro boy with all the farming utensils and the half of the household furniture.

Willing to **JEAN ROBINSON**, his beloved wife half the household furniture and a Negro woman called Silvy with forty dollars from **JOSEPH ROBINSON** if necessity demands.
