 line N. 48. E. 93 poles to a stake 20 poles South from a corner pine, then N. 0. 160 poles to the beginning  
 Together with all and singular, rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises be-  
 longing, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have & to hold, all and singular the premises  
 before mentioned unto the said James Bryan his Heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind  
 myself my Heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
 premises unto the said James Bryan his Heirs and assigns, against myself and my Heirs against  
 every other person or persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

 on the Waters of Doolittles Creek, containing One Hundred Acres, or the same more or less, Be-  
 ginning on a Hickory on the south side of the Meadows on the Waters of Doolittles Creek, running  
 thence N. 28 W. 15 Chains to a Hickory, thence N. 20 E. 33 Chains to Black Oak, thence N. 55 E. 17 Chain  
 to a White Oak Willson's line excluding all lands lawfully claimed by David Roberts thence North
