or his Successors, and other Justices of the County of ~~Cumberland~~  
To the which Payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our Heirs,  
Executors and Administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these Presents. Sealed  
with our Seals, and dated this 4<sup>th</sup> Day of December 1810

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the above bounden  
*James Campbell*

Administrator of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits of  
~~Henry Turner~~ deceased, do make or cause to be made a true and perfect  
Inventory of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits of the de-  
ceased, which have or shall come to the Hands, Knowledge or Possession of the  
said *James Campbell* or into the Hands or Possession of any  
Person or Persons for *Him*, and the same so made,  
do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited in the Secretary's Office, and one attested Copy  
thereof to the County Court where Orders for Administration passed, within ~~Twenty~~  
Days after the Date of these Presents; and the same Goods, Chattels and Credits  
and all other Goods Chattels and Credits of the deceased, at the Time of his Death,  
or which at any Time hereafter shall come into the Hands or Possession of the said  
*James Campbell* or into the Hands or Possession of any other  
Person or Persons for *Him* do well and truly administer  
according to Law: And further do make or cause to be made, a true and just Ac-  
count of ~~his~~ said Administration, within ~~Twenty~~ Days after the Date of  
these Presents, and all the Rest and Residue of the said Goods, Chattels, and Credits,  
which shall be found remaining upon the said Administrat~~a~~ Account (the same  
first being examined and allowed by the Governor and Council, Superior or County  
Court) shall deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons respectively, as the same  
shall become due, pursuant to the true Intent and Meaning of the Act in that Case  
made and provided. And if it shall appear that any Will or Testament was made by  
the deceased, and the Executor or Executors therein named, do exhibit the same in
