In the name of God, Amere: the first day of April 1797

I, David Campbell being of sound and perfect Memory, thanks be to almighty God, and calling to remembrance the uncertain state of this transitory life, and that all flesh must yield unto death, where I shall please God to call, do make and declare this my last will and Testament in manner and form following: First, being penitent and sorry for all my sins, most humbly desiring, forgiveness for the same, & Commanding my soul unto almighty God, my saviour and redeemer, in whom, and by whose merits I trust and believe assuredly to be saved, and to have full remission of the sins of all my sins, and to inherit the Kingdom of Heaven, and my Body &灵魂 to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named as to my worldly estate, & will that all my just debts be paid first.

2. I Give and bequeath unto my Brother Peter Morine Campbell in Scotland, ayele Shair, the sume of thirty, Pounds north Carolina Currency.

3. I Give and bequeath unto Margaret my second daughter living in Scotland, ayele Shair, the sume of twenty Pounds north Carolina Currency.

4. I Give and bequeath unto my Neighbour Anderson the sume of twenty Pounds north Carolina Currency.

5. I Give and bequeath unto Collin Campbell my brother son my Land, &c I Give and bequeath unto my Smith my house Sheep, one and half Acre, &c.

I do constitute and appoint Will Gallreath and John Blue Executors and administrators of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of April 1797.

**K**NOW all Men by these Presents, That *John Campbell Daniel McIntyre*  
*and Grace Tolson* — are held and firmly bound unto the Chairman, and other Justices of the county court of  
*Cumberland* — in the sum of *Four hundred* —  
pounds, current money, to be paid to the said Chairman *Alexander Owen*—  
or his successors, and other Justices of the county of *Cumberland* —  
To the which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, execu-  
tors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our  
seals, and dated this *1st* day of *November 1803* —

**T**HE CONDITION of the above obligation is such, That if the above bounden  
*John Campbell* — administrator of all and  
singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of *Daniel Campbell*  
— deceased, do make or cause to be made, a true and perfect invent-  
ory of all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of the deceased, which  
have or shall come to the hands, knowledge or possession of the said *John* —  
— or into the hands or possession of any person or  
persons for *him* — and the same so made, do exhibit  
or cause to be exhibited in the ~~Secretary's office~~, and one attested copy thereof to the  
county court where orders for administration passed, within *Ninety* —  
days after the date of these presents; and the same goods, chattels and credits, and all  
other goods, chattels and credits of the deceased at the time of his death, or which at  
any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said *John* —  
— or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons  
for *him* — do well and truly administer according to law:  
and further do make or cause to be made, a true and just account of *his* — said ad-  
ministration, within *Ninety* — days after the date of these presents, and  
all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits, which shall be found re-  
maining upon the said administration account (the same being first examined and  
allowed by the Governor and Council, superior or county court) shall deliver and pay  
unto such person or persons respectively, as the same shall become due, pursuant to the  
true intent and meaning of the act in that case made and provided. And if it shall ap-  
pear that any will or testament was made by the deceased, and the executor or ex-cutor's  
therein named do exhibit the same into court, making a request to have it allowed and  
approved of accordingly, if the said *John Campbell* —

above bounden, being thereunto required do render, and deliver the said letters on a li-  
ministration (approbation of such testament being first had and made in the said court)  
then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
