187- Feb. 16, 1806- Court ordered estate of PATRICK
 ORRICK sold by admistr.; sold to JOSEPH ORRICK, PHILIP
 ORRICK, WILLIAM ORRICK, JOHN ORRICK, DENNIS ORRICK
 and others; DENNIS ORRICK, admstr.

190 thru 200- May Court 1806- Division of estate,
 with plate annexed, of JOHN PPOOL (PITTPOOL); ROBERT,
 WILLIE, LOUISA PPOOL (PITTPOOL), WILLIAM WILKES-
 SON, DAVID WILKESON, HUCKLE BOKE, JOHN JONES, lega-
 tees; and SAMFORD, JOHN, JACOB, WILLIAM DISON and HEN-
 RY HENDERSON as heirs; and in behalf of their mother
 MARY DISON, deceased, make bond agreeable and in agree-
 ment in division of this estate; divided into 6 parts
 by CHARLES D. LEWIS and JOHN P. SMITH, attested by LOUD-
 YARD TAYLOR as surveyor of land; the plantation of 250 acres
 with houses is to be retained by SARAH PITTPOOL,
 the widow, and for her lifetime only, and may hire an
 overseer if she wish, and the other seven parts to the
 above mentioned legatees. STEPHEN PITTPOOL received
 from his father in his lifetime and does not take any
 of this land. JOHN PITTPOOL died intestate. The land
 is in Person County on Crooked Fork, Aaron's Creek and
 part of land in Greenville County, N. C.

201,202- Aug. 8, 1806- proved Aug. Court 1806- 200-
 202 DECEASED wills to wife ELIZABETH all stock, household
 furniture, tools, for her lifetime or widowhood and if
 she marries, the property sold and she to receive a
 child's part, all divided to her and all the children
 to son AARON, 100 acres, part of tract wherein I now
 live, and he to pay all my debts after my death to
 son WILLIE and daughter SHELAH, 150 acres after AARON'S
 land taken off, to divide between them with condition
 they care for their brother JOSEPH and sister SUSANNA;
 If they do not, the land taken from them and used for
 JOSEPH and SUSANNA; if SHELAH die without heirs, her
 part to sister ELIZABETH; If WILLIE die, his part to
 sister DEBORAH. EXEC: JOSEPH BULLOCK, wife ELIZABETH,

estate of MARY OLIVER, deceased, not mentioned in will, amongst legatees.

216,217- Aug. Court 1805- To ELIZABETH IRBY, PETER IRBY, JANE IRBY, JOHN IRBY, and MARY CREAM - receive from estate of MARY OLIVER, deceased.

217,218,219- Acct. of sales of estate of JAMES EKOTT, deceased, by JOSEPH HART, exec.; mentions ROSEPOLA EKOTT as buyer, THOMAS, JOHN EKOTT.

220,221,222- Aug. Court 1805- Acct. of JAMES EKOTT, deceased, with JOSEPH HART, executor to THOMAS CREAM, in behalf of his wife ROSEPOLA EKOTT, now CREAM; to JOSEPH EKOTT, son of JAMES EKOTT, deceased, the other half of estate.

222,223- Aug. Court 1805- Inventory of LEWIS ANDERSON, deceased, by STEPHEN COOPER, admstr., which was left in possession of his widow.

223,224- Aug. 1805- MAURICE SMITH appointed Sheriff of county, with JAMES BOWEN, JAS. W. WILLIAM, and ALEXANDER SMITH as bondsmen.

224- Nov. Court 1805- Inventory of estate of THOMAS OWENS, JR., deceased.

225,226- Nov. 6, 1795- proved Nov. Court 1805- ROBERT REED wills to brother CHARLES REED in Scotland all my estate, real and personal, and if he die before I do, then to my brother's sons ROBERT and CHARLES REED all my estate and if they die before me, then to my sister MARION'S children. Exec: GEORGE ALLSTON, JOHN BYTTALL, JAMES HAMILTON. Wts: JAMES BOYD, JOHN BLACKHALL, JONATHAN KITTERELL.

226,227,228- May 28, 1805- proved Nov. Court 1805- ROBERT REED wills to wife MARY FERRY REEDLAND a slave woman and 3 children and 5 negro men slaves until my oldest child is of age (if my wife marry again, then the negroes evaluated and put in 7 lots and given my children with my wife having a child's part) and,

at her death, divided to my children: MARY, ELIZABETH, LUCY, FRANCY, MARY, and MARY ANN RAGLAND; when oldest daughter MARY is of age, certain evaluated and divided for her to get her negroes and a child's part of rest of estate; to two oldest sons ELIJAH and WILLIAM, 2 negroes (at wife's death) and, when of age, the rest of their bequest to them. Same persons continue, JOSEPH COOKES, wife MARY P. RAGLAND, Mrs. JAMES COOKES, WILLIAM RAGLAND.

229,230- Nov. 25, 1807- Inventory of estate of ROBERT RAGLAND by MARY RAGLAND, executrix.

230,231- Nov. Court 1805- Inventory of estate of WILLIAM LILES, deceased, not devised by will.

230,232,233- Accts. of sales of estate of WILLIAM LILES by THOMAS and JACOB LILES, executors.

233- Nov. Court 1805- Inventory of THOMAS BOWLES, deceased, by JORDAN BOWLES (BOTTLES), admtr.

233,234,235- Sept. 1803- Accts. of estate of JOHN COOK, deceased, with JOHN COOKS, Jr., executors; trips to Halifax to Superior Court, to Moore County to satisfy L. COOKING'S debts; settled Nov. 1805.

236- JAMES W. SMITH, County trustee, accts., 1805; many names here cover pages 237,238, most of 239.
