2d. I give and bequeath to my sister Margaret Smith one negroe boy called Sam to her and her heirs forever

3d. I give and bequeath to John Latta my silver Watch

4th I give and bequeath to William A. Latta my gold whatch

5th I give and bequeath to sister Adeline Allison my undevided part of a tract of land lying in the state of Tennessee on duck river, one negroe boy called Anson and all my other property, money in hand or any monies due to me by note book accounts or otherwise to her and her heirs for ever--

I constitute and appoint George Rose to be my Executor to this my last will and testament rattifying and confirming this to be my last will and no other made by me, this twelvth day of April-- in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty--
