First I will that all my lawfull debts be punctually and speedily paid--

Then I Will to my Beloved Daughter Martha Robinson and to the heirs of her Body a negro Woman named Jude and her eight Negro Children Together with all my Lands and Grist Mill & Saw mill & also will that a negro man named Harry & a negro man named Yogue at the Discretion of my Executor be Sold or hired & the money arising therefrom I will to my beloved Daughter Martha Robinson I also will that the Remainder of my Personal property be sold at the Discretion of my Executor & the moneys therefrom I will to my Beloved Daughter Martha Robinson I also will that if my Beloved Daughter Should Die without any lawful heirs that my property Should be Equally Devided amongst Brother Robert Robinsons family---

I do hereby nominate & apoint Samuel Given Exeuctor of this my last will and Testament & Declare this to be my last will & testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 24th day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty one & in the forty fifth year of American Independance
