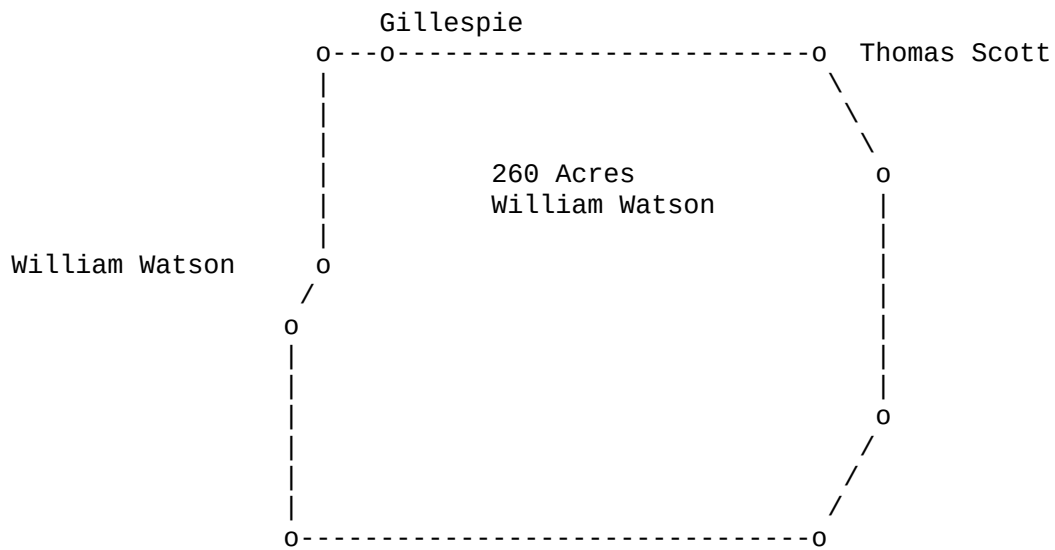
WILLIAM WATSON 260 Acres Tryon on the Waters of Fishing Creek joining his own land.

Beginning at a Black Oak, his own corner, and runs with his own line S 80 W 126 poles to a Hickory, his other corner; thence S 4 E 16 poles to a White Oak, **GILLESPIE**'s corner; thence with his line N 38 E 260 poles to a White Oak; S 74 E 140 poles to a Black Oak; thence joining **THOMAS SCOTT**'s land S 200 poles to a Black Oak; thence to the beginning.
