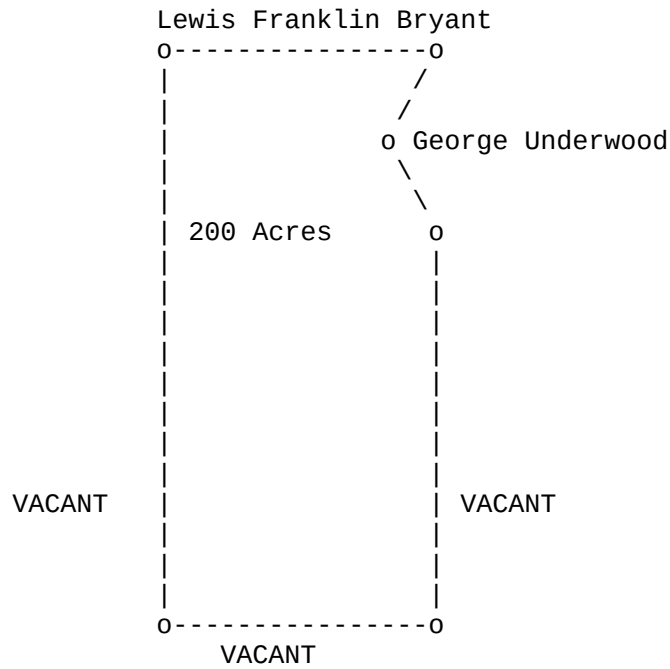


Deed, SC, Craven, George Underwood, 1772



South Carolina

Pursuant to a precept from **JOHN BREMAR**, ESQ. D. D. General dated the 4th day of August 1772 I have admeasured and laid out unto **GEORGE UNDERWOOD** a tract of land containing two [hundred] acres situate in Craven County on the SW side of Big Lynch Creek on three small creeks called Cedar Creeks, bounded NE & NW to George Underwood, NE to **LEWIS FRANKLIN BRYANT**'s land and all other sides to vacant land & hath such shapes & marks as the above plat represents.

Surveyed this 11th day of August 1772
