I, **SAMUEL HEMPHILL** Senior, in a weak and low state of health but in sound mind and memory, call to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death, do make this my last will and testament.

1ST I recommend my soul to God, who gave it, my body to be decently buried.

2ND I allow all my just debts to be paid.

3RD I will & allow my son **ALEXANDER HEMPHILL** to have a part of the tract of land I now live on.

Beginning in a corner of my son **WILLIAM**'s land, a start line; from thence so as to leave out the spring we now use and the barn to **MCSHEWS** line all to the north of said line of my old tract containing sixty acres more or less.

4TH As to all the balance of my land I do allow & will the same to my son **DAVID HEMPHILL**, my wife to have her support off said land her life time.

5TH As to my daughter **MARGRET HEMPHILL** I do allow & will her to be paid fifty dollars.

As to all my stock of horses, cows, sheep, hogs, farming utensils, household furniture & c. I allow to son **DAVID** by his paying the sum of three dollars to each of the rest of my children, viz: **ELIZABETH [HEMPHILL] GRAHAM, MARTHA [HEMPHILL] PATTON, ROBERT HEMPHILL, SAMUEL HEMPHILL, and WILLIAM HEMPHILL.**

And I do hereby will, allow and appoint my beloved wife **SARAH HEMPHILL** and my son **DAVID HEMPHILL** executors of this my last will and testament.

Given under my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of December eighteen hundred & twenty.
