### Solomon Parimore from William Godwin

This Indenture made the Twenty ninth day of August in y<sup>e</sup> year of our Lord seventeen hundred & Seventy two Between William Godwin of the County of Sussex on Delaware yeoman of the one part & Solomon Parimore of said County yeoman of the other Part Whereas Thomas Elton Elizabeth Hill & Thomas Davock had granted to them and confirmed by sundry Patents several Tracts of Land within the County of Sussex afo<sup>r</sup> Situate lying & being on the north side of Long Bridge Branch & adjoining to y<sup>e</sup> same five hundred acres thereof being the most Southern Part of the Whole and Bounded on y<sup>e</sup> afo<sup>r</sup> Branch By sundry Conveyances became the Property of the afo<sup>r</sup> Thomas Davock which said Thomas Davock by his last will and Testament bearing date the twenty seventh day of January in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred & eighteen amongst other things gave Devised and Bequeath to his son Thomas Davock & to his heirs & assigns forever the above recited & Described five hundred acres of land &c and the said Thomas Davock the younger dying Intestate & without issue the afo<sup>r</sup> five hundred acres of land became the Right and Property of his Two Sisters viz Mary & Naomi which s Mary and Naomi by mutual compact Devised the said five hundred acres of land by a line of Marked trees Beginning at a large red oak standing in y<sup>e</sup> wood from thence south twenty one Degrees East one hundred and Twenty Two Paces to a small red oak at the edge of the Branch then on the same line twelve paces to y<sup>e</sup> run of said Branch Mary taking the uppermost and most Western Part thereof Naomi taking the lowermost and most Eastern part and the said Naomi intermarried with a certain Michael Godwin of Worcester County by whom she had several Children & the afo<sup>r</sup> William Godwin being her Eldest Son in the y<sup>e</sup> afo<sup>r</sup> Naomi Godwin died by a certain Instrument of Writing called her last will & Testament the in y<sup>e</sup> lifetime of the afo<sup>r</sup> Michael Godwin gave Devise and Bequeath her Devise of the afo<sup>r</sup> five hundred acres of land to her son William Godwin & to his heirs & assigns forever & thereupon the said Michael Godwin in order to Confirm the title to him the said William Godwin & his heirs as afo<sup>r</sup> was in his Power to Confirm the same did by his Last will and Testament bearing date Decemb<sup>r</sup> in y<sup>e</sup> year of our Lord seventeen hundred and Sixty five give & Bequeath unto y<sup>e</sup> said William Godwin & his heirs and assigns forever the afo<sup>r</sup> moiety or half part of the above described five hundred acres of land.

Now this Indenture witnesseth that y<sup>e</sup> said William Godwin shall for an inforsation of Three Hundred Pounds current money of this Government to him in hand paid by the said Solomon Parimore the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge him self therewith to be fully satisfied contented & grantees bargained sold sold aliened Enfeoffed Conveyed & confirmed by these presents both party & his wife alien Enfeoffed convey and confirm unto him the said Solomon Parimore and to his heirs & assigns the above Easternmost moiety and half part of the above recited & Described five hundred acres of land which is
