

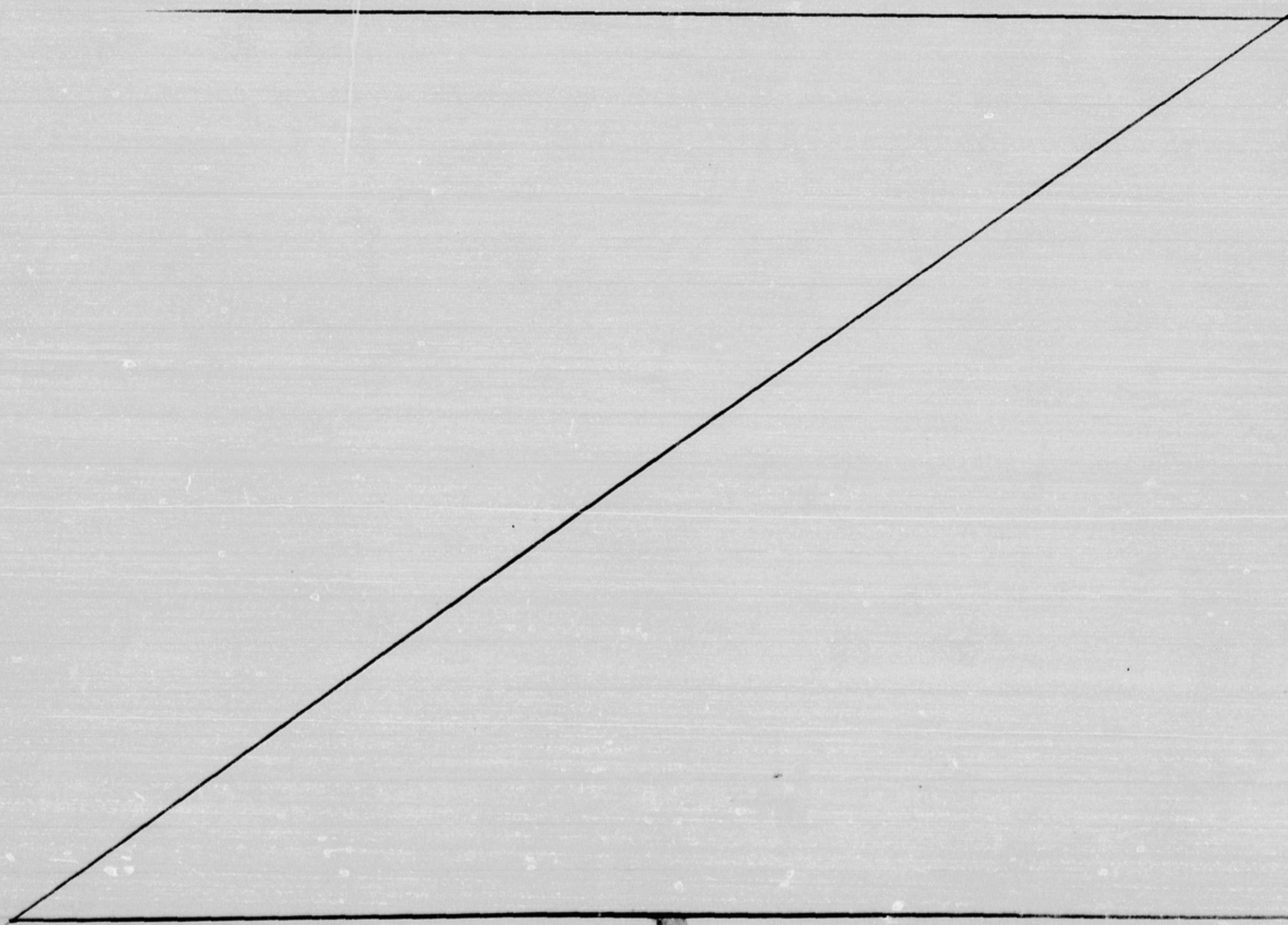
463 **Thomas Price**: 200 Acres Mecklenburgh on a branch of Lives  
Creek of Broad river Beginning at a white oak running thence S<sup>52</sup> E<sup>160</sup> poles to a  
red oak thence S<sup>38</sup> W<sup>200</sup> poles to a hickory thence N<sup>52</sup> W<sup>160</sup> poles to a red oak thence  
N<sup>38</sup> E<sup>200</sup> poles to the Beginning dated 22<sup>d</sup> December 1768. *Wm. Tison.*

464 **Andrew Campbell**: 150 Acres Tison on the waters of  
Allisons Creek joining his own Land Beginning at a white oak by his own  
corner near Robert Adams Land and runs N<sup>60</sup> W<sup>100</sup> poles to a white oak thence  
N<sup>10</sup> E<sup>240</sup> poles to a black oak thence S<sup>62</sup> E<sup>160</sup> poles to a stake his own corner  
thence with his own line S<sup>37</sup> W<sup>160</sup> poles to a pine thence with his other line to the  
Beginning dated 22<sup>d</sup> December 1768. *Wm. Tison.*

465 **Jacob Link**: 353 Acres Tison on the West side of the Cataw-  
ba river on the South fork of Thomas Andersons Mill Creek between said Ande-  
sons and Peter Gausners Land Beginning at a red oak and runs S<sup>283</sup> poles to  
three small black oaks thence W<sup>200</sup> poles to three small black oaks thence N<sup>383</sup>  
poles to a stake thence to the Beginning dated 22<sup>d</sup> December 1768. *Wm. Tison.*

466 **Michael Pickleman**: 600 Acres Tison on  
both sides a main branch of Andersons Mountain Creek including an improve-  
ment Beginning at Sailors corner white oak thence N<sup>60</sup> E<sup>172</sup> poles to a red oak  
in Sollars line thence with Sollars line S<sup>47</sup> E<sup>380</sup> poles to a stake thence S<sup>43</sup>  
W<sup>240</sup> poles to a red oak in Andersons line thence with Andersons line N<sup>47</sup> W<sup>438</sup>  
poles to a red oak in Sailors line and thence with Sailors line to the Beginning  
dated 22<sup>d</sup> December 1768. *Wm. Tison.*

467 **John Polk**: 100 Acres Mecklenburgh on both sides of the Fork  
of Brooks Creek including Jacob Pauls improvement Beginning at a white oak  
on the South side of the creek and runs N<sup>60</sup> W<sup>127</sup> poles to a white oak thence S<sup>60</sup>  
W<sup>127</sup> poles to a white oak thence S<sup>60</sup> E<sup>127</sup> poles to a black oak thence to the Be-  
ginning dated 22<sup>d</sup> December 1768. *Wm. Tison.*
