


Witnesseth that for & in the consideration of the sum of 50 Dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the P. John Milton. Do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Plyler his heirs & assigns for ever a certain piece or parcel of land lying in the County of Mecklenburg in North Carolina BEGYNNING at a P.O. and running S 35 W. to the Stake line & Corner or a Stake then with the Stake line to Peter Bohers Corner then North 40 poles to 2 pines - N 55 E. 120 poles being 47 acres that the P. Otis conveyed to John Milton, and P. Milton to Jacob Plyler jun. to have & to hold to the said Plyler his heirs & assigns for ever the & premises above mentioned, fully to possess and enjoy. And the said John Milton do bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & for ever defend the same, from the claim of myself my heirs & from any other person or persons claiming the same or any part of the same. In Witness hereunto I have set my hand this 5th Oct^r 1800. & 33rd year of our Independence of the United States.

This Indenture made December 1. 1800 Between Mathew Ryan Jun^r of Mecklenburg County in North Carolina of the one part, and Thomas Boyd of the same place of the other part. Witnesseth that for & consideration of the sum of 300 Dollars to the said Ryan in hand paid by the P. Boyd at & before the sealing hereof the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. The the P. Ryan for himself & his heirs doth bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the P. Boyd his heirs & Admin^r and assigns for ever. a certain piece or parcel of land in P. County on the waters of Sugar Creek, bounded on the North & east by the land of W. Jones & on the South by the land of Geo Baker being part of a tract of 150 acres being originally granted to Abraham Faylor deceased being conveyed by P. Faylor to John Smith & from P. Smith to John Ryan & from P. Ryan to Ezekiel Ryan & from P. Ezekiel Ryan to the P. Ryan. BEGYNNING at a B.O. then S 5 W. 66 poles to a B.O. then N 77 W. 76 poles to a W.O. then N 015 W. 010 poles to a pine then N 40 W 36 poles to a B.O. then N 70 W. 7 poles to a B. Jack then N 10 W. 36 poles to a Stake then S 02 E. 60 pole to a hickory thence to the beginning containing 72 acres more or less. To have & to hold the P. 72 acres with the appurtenances & all rights privileges and improvements to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said Boyd and to his heirs Exec^r & Admin^r doth hereby warrant & agree to & with the P. Boyd that he the P. Boyd his heirs & assigns shall & may for ever hereafter peaceably have hold occupy possess & enjoy the P. granted land & premises and every part & parcel thereof without the least molestation of any person whatsoever and the P. Ryan doth Oblidge himself his heirs Exec^r & Admin^r to warrant & for ever defend the P. Land and premises to him the P. Thomas Boyd his heirs & assigns against the just claim of all & every person. This Indenture made January 24th 1809. Between William Hawkins of Mecklenburg County in North Carolina of the one part and John Morris of the same place of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of 430. Dollars to the P. William Hawkins in hand paid by the P. John Morris before the sealing hereof. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Both bargained sold & conveyed and by these presents. Doth grant bargain sell enfeoff and convey unto the P. John Morris his heirs & assigns for ever. a certain piece or tract of land in P. County. containing 166 acres be it more or less on the South side of four mile Creek. BEGYNNING at a hickory on the Creek, Francis M. Crookers corner with his line to a P.O. on David Rays
