The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these
Presents that I Francis Brian of the district of Darlington
in the State of South Carolina aforesaid in Consideration of,
the sum of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Stephen
Williams of the same district & State aforesaid Have
Granted, bargained, sold and Released and by these Presents
do grant Bargain sell and Release unto the said Stephen
Williams, all that plantation or Tract of Land situate lying
and being in the District of Darlington & State aforesaid
in the Fork of Tyger branch and Palmetto Swamp the waters
of Black Creek, Containing by Estimation one hundred acres
be the same more or less, bounded Eastwardly & Northwardly
by the said Tyger Branch, Westwardly by Lands belonging
to Col. John Smith & Edward Roger's & Southwardly by
Lands formerly belonging to Thomas Polk now James
Portick, and hath such shape form & Marks as are repre-
sented in a Plat to the Original Grant annexed Granted to
Joseph Johnson the fourteenth day of August A.D. 1772
Together with all and singular the Rights, members,
Herdiments & Appurtenances unto the said Premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To Have
and to Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned
unto the said Stephen Williams his Heirs & assigns for-
ever, And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs Executors and
Administrators to Warrant and forever defend all & singular
the said Premises unto the said Stephen Williams his Heirs
and assigns, against myself and my Heirs & against all
and every Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully Claiming
or to Claim the same or any Part thereof. Witness my
hand & Seal this Eighteenth day of Nov^r in the year
of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred & one and in
the Twenty Sixth year of North American Independence

 Carolina Planter of the one part and James Pawley George Pawley
 and M^{rs} Hannah Norris of said place of the other part
