The State of South Carolina I know all men by these presents Pendleton District 3 that whereas Peter Keys Esquire of the District and State aforesaid by his deed of gift or bill of sale recorded in the office of Master Conveyancer for the District of Pendleton did, bargained sell, convey and give unto me John M Keys his son the following named Negroes Dublin, Gomar, Celia and George and whereas the said Peter Keys has paid unto the said John M Keys in Cash and property received at different times the sum of one thousand Dollars Now know ye that the said John M Keys being fully satisfied in the premises and having received full and ample compensation and value for the above mentioned slaves have remitted released and forever quit claimed and by these presents do remise release recover, and forever quit claim unto the said Peter Keys his heirs executors and administrators the above named Negro slaves to wit Dublin, Gomar, Celia and George former and his executors and administrators and I do hereby further relinquish unto the said Peter Keys all my right title and interest for claim unto all and every one of the above named Negro slaves. Given under my hand and seal the third day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven and in the fifty second year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America Agreed sealed and delivered in presence of A. It witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of twenty Pounds Sterling Money paid in Hand by said said Nathan Bryant to the said John Null it is agreed the receipt whereof the said John Null doth hereby acknowledge and himself there worth fully satisfied hath granted bargained sold and delivered

and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Nathan Bryant his
 heirs and assigns a certain tract of land or part of land that John Hall now liveth, or situated lying
 and lying in the County of Pendleton County aforesaid on the Big Beaverdam waters of Savanna
 River begining at a Constitutional Corner and running to another Constitutional tree standing near
 John Hall fence a red oak bladed and four steps on the West side of the tree and thence to run
 a strait line to take up the said full one hundred Acres of land and the said Nathan Bryant is
 to have the old boundaries for compliment of four hundred Acres of land more or less running
 west to a black oak, thence 20×3 with 48.30.50 thence N. post oak #68 E 27 thence to a black oak
 #73 E 21 Turkey oak thence to a stake & Eg. 10, thence west 50 E 6 thence to a post oak 7.50.78 to the
 begining tree, and thence to the Constitutional Corner to a red oak. Together with all the rights titles and
 claims and interest whatever of him the said John Hall of and to the said lands and premises
 is to have and to hold the said described land which which containeth four hundred Acres
 of land be the same more or less with to woods water buildings or outbuildings appurtenances rights and
