ander or his associates in trust for the benefit of Zeno
Alexander Minor of Zebulon Alexander dec'd to be
void on condition that Thomas Grier who is appointed
Guardian of Zeno Alexander aforesaid doth well
and faithfully render a just account of his guardianship
and shall truly pay or cause to be paid to said Orphan
when he arrives at full age, or to such Guardian as may
be chosen within that time, all such sums of money
as he shall be liable for, and generally comply with
an Act of Assembly in such case made and pro-
vided: Given under Our hands and seals this twenty
seventh day of July 1787

WITNESSETH, That the said ~~John Wood Alexander Esq; Chairman~~

with the said Isaac Price to live after the manner
of an apprentice and servant, until the said apprentice shall attain to the age of
~~nearly One~~ years, during all which time the said apprentice ~~his~~
~~Master~~ faithfully shall serve, ~~his~~ lawful commands every where gladly obey,
~~he~~ shall not at any time absent ~~himself~~ from ~~his~~ said Master
service without leave, but in all things, as a good and faithful servant, shall be-
have towards his said Master. And the said Isaac Price

doth covenant, promise and agree, to and with the said
~~John Wood Alexander~~ that ~~he~~ will teach and instruct,
or cause to be taught and instructed, the said ~~Lenos Alexander~~
~~to learn to read and write and also~~ the art and mystery of

~~The gun & Smith Trade and also pay to him Thirteen~~
~~bounds in Money or Goods and give him three months~~
~~schooling year third of his time~~

And that ~~he~~ will constantly find and provide for the said apprentice, during
the term aforesaid, sufficient diet, washing, lodging, and apparel, fitting for an ap-
prentice; and also other things necessary, both in sickness and in health. IN WIT-
