EBENEZER FOLSOM, of Cumberland County, North Carolina, was probably a son of Israel<sup>3</sup> Folsom (Samuel<sup>2</sup>, John¹) of Connecticut and New Jersey, and was the Ebenezer Folsom baptized in the Congregational Church in Ashford, Conn. 31 March 1728.
