No 896. Know ye that we have granted unto James Blackman
thou hundred and Ninety three acres of land in Sampson County
in the fork of the six runs and Hoods swamp joining his
own line, Beginning at a ash at the run of Hoods swamp
at the mouth of Michael Kings branch, thence with Kings
line North four West one hundred and ten pole to a pine on
Luke Thomas's line, thence with Thomas's line South Sixty
three West eighty six pole to a stake at the run of a swamp
called the glade of bears, thence with Thomas's line North Sixty
two West Sixty pole to his corner a large white oak, thence
his line North Sixty nine West one hundred and twenty two
pole to his corner a red oak, thence South forty one East twenty
one pole with Blackman's line to his corner a stake, thence
with his line South twenty seven West eighty pole to his corner
a stake, thence with his line West fifty pole to his corner a
stake, thence with his line South thirty West thirty six
pole to his corner stake (formerly a pine) thence with his line
North Sixty West Sixty two pole to a small water oak
by an old corner a dead pine in a marsh, thence South
forty West twenty two pole to a ash at the run of the six
runs, thence down the run as it meanders to the mouth
of Hoods swamp, thence up the run of Hoods swamp as
it meanders to the Beginning. Entered the 15th of Augt 1800.
To Hold to the said James Blackman his heirs and
assigns forever. sealed the 20th day of December 1800.
