with said Alexanders line to the Beginning. Entered the
6th of January 1797. To Hold to the said Matthew Brian
his heirs and assigns forever. dated 22^d of November 1800.

sixty two poles to a post oak said Parks other corner, thence
with Charles Hendersons line North sixty five west fifty
