KNOW all Men by these Presents, That William Land

HE CONDITION of this Obligation is such, that if the above bounder administrat of all and singular the goods and chattles, rights and credits of a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods and chattles rights and credits of the deceased, which have or shall come to the hands, knowledge, or possession of the said William Les \_\_\_ or into the hands or possession of any person or persons for him; and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited into Mushlending county court, within the time prescribed by law, after the date of these presents: And the same goods, chattles and credits, and all other the goods chattles and cre lits of the deceased, at the time of had death, or which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said Milliams or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him do well and truly administer according to law; and further do make, or cause to be made a true and just account of he said administration, agreeable to law, after the date of these presents: and all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattles and credits, which shall be found remaining upon the said administrates account (the same being first allowed by the Govenor and Council, Superior or County Court shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as the same shall become due, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the act in that case made and provided.
