# State of North-Carolina.

KNOW all men by these presents, That *Sarah Robison, William*  
*Thomson & Robert Barnett* are held and firmly bound unto the Chairman and other justices of the  
 county court of *Muhlenburg* — in the sum of *Five*  
*Hundred* pounds current money, to be paid  
 to the said Chairman *William Wilson* or his successors,  
 and other justices of the county of *Muhlenburg* —  
 To the which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves,  
 our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly  
 by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this *23<sup>d</sup>*  
 day of *October* — Anno Domini 1797

THE CONDITION of the above OBLIGATION is such, That  
 if the above bounden *Sarah Robison, William Thomson*  
*& Robert Barnett* — administrators of all and sin-  
 gular the goods and chattles, rights and credits of *Richard*  
*Robison* — deceased, do make or cause  
 to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods  
 and chattles, rights and credits of the deceased, which have or shall  
 come to the hands, knowledge or possession of the said *admini*  
*strators* — or into the hands or possession of  
 any person or persons, for *them*  
 and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited in the secre-  
 tary's office, and one attested copy thereof to the county court where  
 orders for administration passed, within *ninety*  
 days after the date of these presents; and the same goods chattles and  
 credits, and all other goods, chattles and credits of the deceased at the  
 time of his death, or which at any time hereafter shall come into the  
 hands or possession of the said *Sarah Robison William*  
*Thomson & Robert Barnett* do well and truly admin-  
 ister according to law: and further do make or cause to be made, a  
 true and just account of *this*  
 said administration, within *ninety* days after the date of  
 these presents. and all the rest and residue of the said goods, chattles  
 and credits, which shall be found remaining upon the said administrat-  
 ion — account (the same being first examined and allowed by the go-  
 vernor and council, superior or county court) shall deliver and pay  
 unto such person or persons respectively, as the same shall become due,  
 pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the act in that case made  
 and provided. And if it shall appear that any will or testament was  
 made by the deceased, and the executor or executors therein named  
 do exhibit the same into court, making a request to have it allowed  
 and approved of accordingly, if the said *Administrators*  
 above bounden, being thereunto required  
 do render and deliver the said letters on administration (approbation  
 of such testament being first had and made in the said court) then this  
 obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
