the said deceased, and also auditing the accounts, calculations and reckonings of the said
administration, and a final discharging of the same, to me is manifestly known to belong : I,
desiring that the goods and chattels, rights and credits of the said deceased, may be well and
truly administered, applied and disposed of, " according to law," do hereby grant unto the said

in whose fidelity, in this behalf, I confide full power by the tenor of these presents, to adminis-

true and perfect inventory thereof, and to exhibit the same into the Probate Office in
Union in order to be recorded, on or before the *20th*
day of *December* now next ensuing ; and to render a just and true account,
calculation and reckoning of the said administration, when thereunto required : And I ordain,
depute and constitute you, the said *S. W. Porter*

Administrator of all and singular the goods, chattels, rights and credits of the said deceased.
