ministrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid,
if demanded, the principal Sum of *Two Pounds two Shillings
and ten Pence half Penny*
on the *Twenty-fourth of January 1787*
And the said *Francis Bryant*
his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, may make any Purchases at
any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered
by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be re-
ceived in Payment.

For the true performance of the several payments in manner above men-
tioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of
the STATE pledged by the aforesaid ACT.
