In the name of God amen

I Obenya Fobson of Cumberland County & State of North Carolina
being weak of Body but of perfect mind & memory do make and
ordain this my last will & testament hereby revoking and utterly -
canceling all and every other testament I will by one made -
Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament
after payment of all my just debts & funeral charges
I will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Edith one Negro fellow
Pandoo and also one wrench Filler at his own disposal but
the first child that Filler has I give to Amoy Bryan and also I
give to my wife one third of all my pasture and one chest and
two pots and five cows & calves also two beds & furniture and
likewise five hundred weight of meat and twenty Barrels of
corn and twenty bushels wheat and likewise one bay mare
Jesus be Pised to her during her Natural life three hundred
acres of land in Johnson county joining William Bryan and
after her death I give it to Meedham Bryan his son and
I bind her one Negro boy called Will during her Natural life
and after her death to be equally divided as my other estate and
~~my executor is to build a house on said land twenty by sixteen~~
frame? of plank floor and clear ten acres of land on the side
and build a smoke house & milk house and is not to move
from the main plantation until it is completed -
and I give & bequeath unto my son Israel one Negro fellow
Simon and forty pounds and I give to my son Nathaniel
one Negro fellow Gecey & fifty pounds I give to my son
Obenya forty pounds to my sons George & Thomas I give
fifty pounds each for their schooling & the remaining part
of my real & personal estate I leave & give to my seven children
to be equally divided by my executors at their and according to
their discretion and Lastly I hereby constitute make & appoint
and ordain my three sons Israel Nathaniel & William my
executors of this my last will & testament In Winston whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twentieth day of
August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
eighty eight
