I give to my Grandson Israel Robertson son of David Robertson Twenty Shilling

Item I give to my son Nicholas Robertson five Shilling Starling

I give to my grand daughter Alice Robertson Daughter of my son Nicholas Robertson Twenty Shilling

I give to my son Charles Robertson five Shilling Starling

I give to my Grandson Fulks son of Charles Robertson Twenty Shilling

I am - I give to my Daughter Anna Hendrick a Negroe Boy - named - gummie

I am - I give my Son George Robertson three Negroes ~~two~~ - a negro woman named Doll and a negroe
named Tom a negroe gall named - Frank sixteen head of Cattel three peccars
Beds - all the other Rduel good that a - belongs to the house my plantation of now lies
on and mill and all the Land Belong ~~to~~ to me to Sarah Robertson my beloved wife
The mother of George or so have a living - In the estate I left to George During his Life
and there by a point my Son David Robertson and my Son George Robertson Executors
that this my will be performed to the intent and meaning thereof - of

the day and year
