Next I give to Brother John Boal the thin Cloas with the new Leather Bouches one Buckskin not made up ~~one hat~~ ~~one~~ two pair of Wisted Stockens one one hat the Bay Mare With the White in his face to Sister Margaret Boal I Leave my Silver Buckels to James Boal a child I Leave my Saddlebags son to John Boal

Next I Leave to Brother Thomas McClure the Blue Sawt of Cloas that is here and a fewt of Cloas that is in Pennsylvania also one shirt and one hat ~~one pair of~~ ~~three~~ Stockens one Brown Mare

Next I Leave my Saddle and Bridle to Moses McClure a child son to Thomas McClure First thing to be done with the Money is to bury me decently Next to pay all Lawfull debts there is m<sup>o</sup>: alexander Stepins and there is nine Shillings to be paid to Robert Mountgomery and Six Shillings to James Mountgomery the money that is due to me that I have no notes for I mention here there is three pounes in Robert McEes hand and 80 in alexander Michels hand and 28 6 in Nathan hakenses hand

There is something in John Prices hand But  
how much I cannot tell he has paid to me ten  
pounds and when the house is measured it can  
be told what is remaining  
and next I allow all the money to be divided  
into two equal shares between John Boal  
and Thomas McClure the gray mare I allow to  
sold and his price to be divided equally between  
the said Boal and McClure

Ratifying and confirming this and no other  
to be my last will and testament in witness  
whereof I have hereto set my hand and  
seal w<sup>t</sup>
