IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN, January y'e 15th 1784 I Catharine Berry of State of South Carolina, Camden District being weak of body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say.

First I give and bequeath to my Daughter Violet Simril five Shillings Sterling.

Secondly. I give and bequeath to my Son Hugh Berry five Shillings Sterling.

Thirdly. I give and bequeath to my daughter Catharine Barron my Bed with its furniture and likewise all my wearing Body Cloaths to equally divided betwixt my daughters Violet Simril and my daughter Catharine Barron.

Fourthly. I give and bequeath to my Son John Berry five Shillings Sterling.

Fifthly. I give and bequeath to my Son Andrew Berry five Shillings Sterling

Sixthly. I give and bequeath to my son William Berry the Plantation that I now live upon.

Seventhly. I give and bequeath to my Son Roger Berry three grown Cows and Calves.

Eighthly. I give and bequeath to my son Richard Barry five shillings Sterling.

And I do hereby make and ordain my Sons Hugh and William Barry Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I the said Katharine Barry have to this my last Will and Testament set my Hand and Seal, the Day and year above written.
