Arthur Whitehead Being in perfect health and
 Memory Thanks be to God for the same do consider
 the Uncertainty of this Life Think proper & necessary
 for to settle my worldly affairs in some small measure
 or form & as for what little worldly Estate the Lord in
 his Marcey hath been Pleas'd to induce me with my
 Intention & meaning is to leave It as followeth viz^t
 Item I give & demise unto my Eldest Son Arthur
 Whitehead the Plantation whereon he now Lives &
 being on the South west side of a Swamp called the
 Cabben Swamp & from the Mill Cartepaith down
 the said Swamp & up the said Cartpaith to M^r
 Turners Line down the said Line to the Syprus
 Swamp & down the said to a line of marked trees
 & so to the head of a Branch called the Tachel
 Branch the said Land I give to the said Arthur White
 head & the heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten
 forever Item I give & demise unto the aforesaid
 Arthur a Negro man Named Pompey to him & his
 heirs Lawfully Begotten forever Item I give
 & demise unto my Gran ^{Son} ~~Daughter~~ Arthur White
 head a Negro Boy Named Luck to him & his heirs
 forever Item I give & demise unto my Son Lewis
 Whitehead the Plantation whereon Snow dwell
 & the Plantation a servant to the same that I
 bought of M^r Bowers with one hundred & seventy five
 Acres of Land belonging to the same to the said Lewis
 & his heirs Lawfully Begotten forever Item I give
 & demise unto my son Lewis Whitehead & his heirs

Lawfully Begotten of his Body a parcel or devident
of Land out in the pine woods lying between the
Mill path & the long branch to him & his heirs for
ever Item I give & demise unto my son Lewis White
head & the heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten
a plantation Meher in River bounded as followeth
from the County Line up the said River to a Deep
Gutt & up the said Gutt & through the Mill Swamp
to the corner tree & also a parcel of Land lying on
Pottycassey Creek in Carolina to him & his heirs
forever Item I give & demise unto the said Lewis
one Negro man called Mingo & also a negro Woman
called Phillis & a Negro Boy called Peter to him & the
heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten forever after my
Decease & his Mothers with the Increase of the said
Phillis Item I also give & demise unto the said Lewis
Whitehead & his heirs all my house hold goods which is
in the low Room of my New dwelling house to him &
his heirs Lawfully Begotten forever & also the Sti
of two Guns which he shall think best to Chase
I also give & demise unto the said Lewis White
& his heirs Twenty head of Grown Cattle & all
that shall be at the said Plantation what I have
given to the said Lewis Whitehead & also my own
ing horse with the Accutermments belonging to
Horse & also a young mare & all my working Tools
of every sorte Item I lend the Use of the
of Land belonging to the same with the Mill
Nathan Whitehead now Dwells & also a parcel of

Land upon Nehuin River from the deep Gut up
the said River in one acre called his March during
his Natural Life & after his decease I will Item
I give & demise the aforesaid Plantation & Land unto
my Grand Son Benjamin Whitehead & to the heirs
Body Lawfully Begotten forever I also Lend unto
my son Nathan Whitehead the use of two Negroes
one called Dick & his wife called Rose during his
Natural Life & after his decease I will I give & demise
unto my Grand son Benj^m Whitehead the afore
mentioned Negroes Dick & Rose with their Increase
that shall be after he the said Nathan Whitehead is
or shall be in possession or possess with the said slaves
to the said Benj^m Whitehead & his heirs Lawfully begot
ten forever I will I give & demise unto my son Nathan
Whitehead & the heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten
Two hundred Acres of Land lying on the South Side
of a Swamp called pollocks Between Dam ajauans

Near to my plantation the said Land being in
line over fishing Creek the said Land to him & his
heirs forever I also give to my son Nathan one feather
Bed & Furniture besides the Bed he had before and
also six Cows & Calves & one Gun besides the before
& one Iron pot & three a dozen Butter plates & dishes
& 5. ^{sons} & one breeding mare & one Grin stone & two Iron
Nagges I will I lend to my Daughter Patience Dick a
parcel or Dividend of Land being adjacent to the said
Jacob Dick's Plantation & so running down the said
Swamp to a franch called the Long branch being
about four hundred Acres with the use of the said Land
during her Natural Life & after her Decease I will I give

I give & demise the aforesaid Land to my Grandson Jacob Dick
 & to the heirs of his Body Lawfully Begotten forever
 also give to the aforesaid Grandson one Negro Boy Called
~~Samuel~~ ^{mentioned} & one feather Bed & furniture to him & his heirs
 forever Item I give & demise unto my Daughter Patient
 with five Shillings Item I give & demise unto my Dau-
 ghter Catrin with five Shillings & also demise that she
 nor her heirs may or shall have any more of my Estate
 then what she ~~the~~ ^{the} said Catrin hath had before
 Item I give & demise unto my Daughter Mary White-
 head & her heirs Lawfully Begotten of her Body at Lan-
 tation with two hundred Acres of Land belonging to
 the same forever the afore mentioned Plantation being
 on the South Side of Fishing Creek on a swamp Called
 the Beaver Dam Item I also give my said Daughter
 Mary a Negro Gail Called Toney to her & his heirs
 with the Increase of the said Negro forever Item I also
 give to my said Daughter Mary one feather Bed &
 furniture Item I give & demise unto my Daughter Ann
 Whitehead & to the heirs of her Body Lawfully Begotten
 a Plantation on Southwest Side of Swift Creek with
 the Dividend of Land thereto belonging forever Item
 I also give unto my aforesaid Daughter Ann a Negro
 Boy Called Toney & also a feather Bed & furniture
 to her & her heirs Lawfully Begotten forever
 And as for what small part of my Estate is not already
 given I constitute appoint & Devise my Loving to the wth
 Whitehead & Cap^t Tho^s Jamell & M^r James Washington to

Divide what shall appere without dowry & within
dowry Equily between my son & his three sisters
Patience & Mary & Ann I do hereby constitute or
Demand appoint my son Lewis Whitehead my full
and sole Exors of this my last Will & Testament the
Witness my hand & seal this Twelth day of March
one thousand seven hundred & forty four
my Desire & meaning is that my whole Estate may remain as it
now is until after my loving wifes
Decease & that she may have her proper
Support & Maintainance out of the same
During her natural Life
